### VENTURA FREEWAY STATE ROUTE 134 (SR-134) CLOSURES

**BURBANK TO GLENDALE** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of SR-134 for a repaving project on the Ventura Freeway (SR-134) between Bob Hope Drive and the Glendale Freeway (SR-2). Ramp closures will be staged so that no two consecutive ramps are closed at the same time. The following closure schedule will be in effect, weather permitting:

#### **Saturday, May 15 and Sunday, May 16**

##### **Lanes and ramps will be closed as needed within the times indicated**

- 4 p.m. to 1 p.m. – One lane east- and westbound between Bob Hope Drive and Harvey Drive
- 4 p.m. to 5 p.m. – Connector from northbound I-5
- 4 p.m. to 3 p.m. – East and westbound ramps at Harvey Drive, Glendale Avenue, Brand Boulevard, Central Avenue, Pacific Avenue, San Fernando Road, Zoo Drive, Victory Boulevard/ Riverside Drive, Forest Lawn Drive and Buena Vista Drive

#### **Monday, May 17 through Thursday, May 20**

##### **Lanes and ramps will be closed as needed within the times indicated**

- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – One lane east- and westbound between Bob Hope Drive and Harvey Drive
- 4 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Intermittently, connector from northbound I-5
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – East- and westbound ramps at Harvey Drive, Glendale Avenue, Brand Boulevard, Central Avenue, Pacific Avenue, San Fernando Road, Zoo Drive, Victory Boulevard/ Riverside Drive, Forest Lawn Drive and Buena Vista Drive

State Route 134 is a heavily traveled freeway used by commuters and commercial vehicles. Resurfacing of ramps will provide a smoother safer drive for more than 220,000 vehicles daily traveling this 6.5 mile portion of the Ventura Freeway. The project is expected to complete summer 2010. All American Asphalt is the contractor on this \$1.3 million project, primarily funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act. Caltrans advises motorists to “**Slow For The Cone Zone.**”
